The fall's expeditions answer the following guiding questions:

- *K – What is the best way to learn?*
- *1st – How does nature inspire our problem-solving/inventions?*
- *2nd – How do we read the land to interpret the past? How is the land changing at Popham & Seawall Beach, and how can we help?*
- *3rd – What do Maine plants and animals need to survive? How can we help a Maine endangered species?*
- *4th – How did glaciers impact the Maine landscape? How does the land continue to grow?*
- *5th – How can I help steward food security and health of my community and the Earth through awareness of my food waste?*
